Blended Intensive Program (BIP)

Fostering student participation for a more interconnected European Education Area

This Blended Intensive Program will equip students with key competences to boost transnational student participation within European Universities alliances and other forms of deep transnational cooperation between higher education institutions. Student will learn from successful practices from across the European Education Area and work collaboratively, both with other students and with staff, to come up with relevant ideas that can be implemented in higher education institutions. The program will place a special focus on the key skills that are needed to successfully conduct representation activities, such as teamwork, communication or strategic planning.

In order to boost synergies and develop collaborative skills among students, the BIP will be organized in parallel to other BIP for staff members, and participants will have targeted interactions with them, which will also enrich the content of the other program.

The impact of the program seeks to go beyond its final date, as students will be asked to bring back to their communities the conclusions from the event and engage in discussions with the local students involved in the European Universities Initiative

Online Component: Monday, 27th of May, Friday, 12th of July

The online component will combine best practice sharing with individual research work that will feed into the content of the physical component. Students will be asked to research about the different institutions participating in the BIP using a "bench learning" approach, in which they will compare their institutions with other institutions participating in the program.







Program of Physical Mobility: Monday 24th of June/Friday 28th of June (arrival 23rd, departure 29^{th)})

During the physical mobility, collaborative interactive work will be prioritized Students will brainstorm, debate and challenge their own ideas through different collaborative activities. Each day will be concluded with spaces for reflection in order to process the main takeaways of the day, and to ensure a smooth learning experience that leads to concrete outcomes. Considering the impact - oriented approach of the program, the final days of the BIP will focus on developing proposals for actions that can be implemented in the local realities.
