

Christophe Roche (<https://christophe-roche.fr/>) has been ERA Chair Professor in Artificial Intelligence for Social Sciences and Humanities at the University of Crete (Greece) since 2023, Full Professor in Artificial Intelligence at the University Savoie Mont Blanc (France) from 1988 to 2023, Emeritus from 2023. He has also been a Special Appointment Professor at the University of Liaocheng (China) since 2017, and an ISO expert since 2010 (Project Leader of the ISO 1087:2019 Standard on Terminology). Christophe Roche was also a researcher and lecturer at the University Nova of Lisbon (Portugal) from 2009 to 2022, and Chairman of the Terminology Committee of AFNOR (French Organization for Standardization, Paris) from 2014 to 2023. He set up the annual TOTh conferences (Terminology & Ontology: Theories and applications), which he has organised and chaired since their inception in 2007 (<https://toth.condillac.org/>). Christophe Roche has set up and participated in 14 international projects, including 10 European-funded projects, and a National Talent in Artificial Intelligence (China, 2021-2022). He has delivered more than 150 presentations and publications. His main domains of interest are Artificial intelligence, Linguistics, Terminology, Semantic Web, and Digital Humanities.
