Eleni Katsarou is Professor of Curriculum Theory and Teaching at the Department of Primary Education. Her research and publications focus on teaching theory, educational research (especially action research) and literacy issues and the teaching of Modern Greek as L1 in the context of the New Literacy Studies. He is the (co-)author of many educational materials taught in secondary schools in Greece, three scientific books on research-action, critical literacy and democracy in schools and many articles (more than 60) published in international and Greek journals and edited volumes. In addition, she has (co-)edited three edited volumes on multimodality in education and research-action.

Currently (2023) she participates in the research teams implementing (7) seven research projects (5 European and 2 national). In her most recent projects she explores the complex concepts of critical digital literacy and literacy in artificial intelligence. She is a member of the research team of the European HORIZON project "TALOS - AI4SSH" (Artificial Intelligence for Social Sciences and Humanities).
