

Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees

...in brief:

- Highly integrated joint Master study programmes of excellent quality to attract the very best students worldwide
- Delivered by an international HEI consortium from Programme Countries and (if relevant) Partner Countries
- No restriction in disciplines
- Four (4) consecutive student intakes covered by one Grant Agreement
- Duration of each intake 12 18 24 months (60 90 120 ECTS credits)
- Mandatory study period in at least two (2) different Programme Countries (no virtual mobility)
- Minimum required involvement of invited scholars/guest lecturers in each intake

 Award of fully recognised and accredited joint / multiple (double) Erasmus Mundus Master degrees




Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees

...in brief:

- Increased budget for the 7-years-period
 - around 1 billion €
 - allowing to support ≈ 300 EMJMDs and
 - > **28.000 scholarship holders -** 75% for students from Partner Countries
- Selection results 2014 2017 (by academic discipline)





Taking part as an organisation



- EMJMDs are open to public or private organisations in Programme & Partner Countries
 - > HEIS
 - Non-academic partners (enterprises, non-profit organisations, NGOs, foundations, etc.)
- Applicant must be HEI established in Programme Country & applies on behalf of the EMJMD consortium
- Minimum EMJMD consortium composition
 - > 3 HEIs as partners (including the coordinator)
 - from at least 3 different Programme Countries
- Associated partners (optional): specific tasks/activities
 (e.g. dissemination, knowledge and skills transfer, internships, etc.)

Taking part as an individual

Students apply directly to the EMJMD consortium

EMJMD scholarship holders:

- ✓ must have a first higher education degree or equivalent
- ✓ must not have received an Erasmus Mundus Master Course and/or Erasmus Mundus Joint Doctorate scholarship/fellowship in the past
- can submit a scholarship application to maximum three EMJMD programmes
- ✓ must sign a student agreement with the EMJMD consortium





EMJMD Award criteria (1)


- ✓ Relevance of the project (max 40 points)
- ✓ Quality of the project design and implementation (max 20 points)
- ✓ Quality of the project team & the cooperation arrangements (max 20 points)
- ✓ Impact and dissemination (max 20 points)
- Peer review by independent external experts
 - 3 experts assess each proposal
 - one-step evaluation procedure
- 2 thresholds
 - √ 75% (30 points) of the maximum allocated points for "Relevance"
 - ✓ proposals must score at least 70 points overall





EMJMD Award criteria (2)

Additional scholarships for 8 targeted regions



✓ Consortia may receive up to 48 additional scholarships

Assessment of the criterion:
 "Yes"/"No" – pertinence



^{*} Scholarship amounts for travel/installation depend on the place of residence at the time of scholarship application



New elements in the 2018 EMJMD call

- four (4) student intakes per EMJMD (max duration 6 years)
- max 15 scholarships (Heading1) per intake (total 60 scholarships)
- up to 12 additional scholarships (Heading4 / EDF) per intake for targeted regions of the world (total 48 scholarships)
- Programme Country scholarships offered to the consortia increase (75% share of Partner Country scholarships take into account Heading1 and Heading4 / EDF budgets together)



Key messages & lessons learned

- Build up HEI consortia with a wide coverage of the EHEA
- Invest in internship programmes
- Participation of non-academic organisations in curriculum development and performance evaluation
- Develop complementary competences for EM students
- Business and marketing plans for financial sustainability
- Outreach activities to raise visibility and recognition of awarded joint degrees among academia and business community





EMJMD call for proposals 2018



- Deadline: 15 February 2018 12:00 CET (Brussels time)
- Budget: ~120 mil € (+) ~32 mil € for targeted regions
- N° of projects: ~45 EMJMDs
- N° of scholarships per intake/per project:
 - ~15 (around 60 per Grant Agreement)
 plus
 - ~ 12 (around 48 per Grant Agreement) for targeted regions
- Award decision: by July 2018
